Taste of Faith will be livestreamed Saturday, Aug. 7, 2021 at 7 p.m. on tasteoffaith.org for everyone to watch and participate. Would you consider helping to promote this event by inviting your friends to participate? Perhaps you might consider hosting a Zoom or Facebook watch party.

A few ideas you might consider: Invite some guests to a Zoom party or a Facebook watch party to enjoy the event together virtually. Or, if you choose, have an in-person watch party in your home or backyard.

As a virtual host you play a vital role in the success of this event, but more importantly, in the formation and education of many candidates for the priesthood. With three new seminarians this year, we now have a total of 24 seminarians. This is definitely a blessing worth celebrating! There will be no tickets or any special, financial record-keeping to worry about. Your role is important as a host to making this year's virtual Taste of Faith a success.

We ask that you do the following:

- Please invite friends to watch the event live at 7 p.m. Have fun!
- Send "Save-the Date" reminders to your guests as they accept the invitation via mail, Facebook, Zoom, etc. and with all friends and family you may come in contact with.
- Confirm your RSVPs with these guests by reminding them personally by phone, text, e-mail or social media a couple days before the event.
- Keep a separate list of those unable to commit to watch but who have said they would like to receive more information about the seminarian fund.
